



## TROOP 778 CANOE TRIP AND CAMPOUT

**September 21 – 23, 2018**  
**Current River**  
**Jadwin, MO**



Meet at Stanton at 5:45 pm on the 21st. Leave Stanton at 6:00 pm.

Return to Stanton between 12:00 – 12:30 pm on Sunday 23rd.

Families are Welcome

Transportation Cost: \$5.00, payable in cash only on September 21st.

Cost Per Person: \$ 25.00 (\$22.50 for half of a Canoe + \$ 2.50 per night for camping). Pay with cash, a check payable to Troop 778, or with your Scout account. Payment and the attached permission slip are due at the Troop meeting on September 19th. Food will be purchased by Patrol as usual.

We will travel to Jadwin Canoe Rental on Friday night (2.5hrs) and set up camp. On Saturday at 10am, we will be transported to Cedar Grove and float (fiberglass Canoes/Kayaks) to Akers Ferry (8 mile float).

Meals: Cooked breakfast on Saturday morning. Lunch (to be stored in a Bucket or Wet Dry bag) and drinks (In a secure cooler while on the river). Cooked dinner w/ dessert for Saturday night. Non-cooked breakfast for Sunday morning. All menus must be approved by SPL/ASPL/Scoutmaster/Assistant Scoutmaster at the September 5th Troop Meeting.

Scouts should bring for the Float: Swim Suit and Shirt for the river, old tennis shoes or secure sandals (**No Flip Flops**), hat, Beach Towel, 2 Water Bottles. Bunge Cords/Rope. **Sun Screen (must)**. Water Gun (Approved by SPL)

Seat Cushions and Life Jackets will be provided by Jadwin, along with paddles and trash bags.

Other Gear: Sleeping Bag, Sleeping Mat, Pillow(optional), Flash Light/headlamp (readily available, because we will be setting up in the dark), rain gear, jacket, Camp Chair, Mess Kit w/ Utensils(marked), dry clothes for after float (Shirt, Pants/Shorts, socks, underwear, belt if necessary), Boots or Tennis Shoes.

### **Bath Rooms Available (Flush toilets) and Showers (cost 50 cents)**

Scouts who have passed the BSA swimmer's test will be allowed to canoe together. Non-swimmers will canoe with an adult. There will be opportunities to swim while on the river. Scouts will be expected to stay out of the water unless two or more adults are present and permission has been given. All Scouts will be expected to follow the directions of any adult, the SPL and the ASPL during the canoe float.

Fishing is okay during the canoe trip. Bring your own Fishing Pole and small (Secure) tackle box (You will be responsible for this gear while on the Float). Anyone 16 or older **MUST** have a Valid Missouri Fishing License.
